This year marks the 100th anniversary for the Spencer County Bank. On September 6th, 1907, the bank was founded by seven men: John C. Jolly, Schuler Ferguson, L. H. McCoy, S. W. Gwaltney, W. H. Parker, Charles Schumacher and Thomas Axton. The bank is currently locally-owned by approximately 150 stockholders and is an independent community bank.



The Spencer County Bank is headquartered in Santa Claus, with four other locations - St. Meinrad, Richland, Grandview and Dale. Each location is a full service branch offering checking, savings, certificates of deposit, loans of any type, discount brokerage services and a full service insurance agency. The Santa Claus location is open 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. CST Monday through Thursday. The branches are open 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. CST on those days. All locations are open 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. CST on Friday and 8:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. CST on Saturdays.

Within our cooperative serving area we continue to expand our broadband network and have added many new DSL Internet customers. PSCty, our cable TV service, has made significant inroads and we continue to introduce it to an ever-growing customer base.

Outside our cooperative area our fiber optics network expansion into communities such as Jasper, Huntingburg and southern Perry County is starting to grow and prosper. This regional network, (known as R-Net), will be a driving influence on local economic development. In addition, our Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) project in the town of Ferdinand has been well received. PSC has approximately 60% of the community pre-subscribed for our services. Installation at these Ferdinand homes and businesses has just begun and will be ongoing for the next few months.

This coming year will be no different when it comes to staying busy and working our many plans. Planned for 2008 are engineering and design studies to help guide us on deploying FTTH throughout our cooperative area. Enhancement and expansion of our co-op's broadband network will enable improvements to our current offerings, as well as creating new ones. More information on PSC's FTTH plans will be forthcoming in future newsletters.

All this progress, however, would not be possible without you . . . our members and customers. Our entire PSC organization joins in expressing our appreciation for your business and friendship and we wish you and your family a warm, joyous holiday season and a prosperous, healthy New Year. You truly make a difference in our success.

Chocolate Snowball Cookies

- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 tablespoons cocoa
- 1/4 cup evaporated milk
- 1 3/4 cup flour
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup plus 3 tablespoons butter
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 cup walnuts

Mix 1 cup powdered sugar and 1 teaspoon vanilla and set aside. Cream butter until fluffy. Beat in evaporated milk and vanilla. Add dry ingredients and nuts. Shape into one inch balls. Bake at 325 degrees for 15 to 20 minutes. Roll immediately in vanilla and powdered sugar mixture.
